



GIRL SCOUTS AT SCHOOL SCHOOL VISIBILITY PATCH

Purpose: To help make Girl Scouting more visible to peers and school personnel and to present a positive image of Girl Scouting. By letting your school know Girl Scouts are there, it will encourage non-Girl Scouts to join.

Choose activities in each section to earn the patch.

SCHOOL VISIBILITY

Letting the school know you're there

Choose 2 activities:

- Put up a bulletin board display in your school showing your troop's activities using pictures, event fliers, patches, etc. Display needs to be up at least one month if possible.
- 2. Do a flag ceremony at your school during Girl Scout Week. Girls should be in Girl Scout uniforms or Girl Scout T-shirts if they do not have a uniform.
- 3. Do something special for the teachers, staff, or principal at your school to show appreciation for what they do.
- 4. Put a Girl Scout news article in your school newspaper/newsletter or place a Girl Scout ad in your school yearbook.
- 5. Invite a teacher to help with an activity or badge.

SERVICE TO YOUR SCHOOL

Make your school a better place

Choose 1 activity:

- 1. Volunteer as a troop to help with a special project at school.
- 2. With your school's permission, plant flowers in a vacant spot on the school grounds.
- 3. With your school's permission, paint trashcans in colorful patterns.
- 4. Assist the PTA with one of their meetings by doing a flag ceremony, handing out printed materials, etc.

MAKE NEW FRIENDS

Extend membership to people at your school

Choose 1 activity:

- 1. Invite a non-Girl Scout as a guest to a troop meeting, field trip, or service unit event.
- 2. Volunteer to organize rainy day activities or games during recess.
- 3. Volunteer to help during the Girl Scout Recruitment Event at your school.





4. Recruit a new girl member and have her register with your troop.
