Beginning **November 1, 2022**, the scholarship application will be available online at www.gseok.org/scholarship. Your application will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Girl Scout Experience
- Leadership
- Service
- Academics
- Essay Quality
- Financial Need

The deadline for submission of your completed scholarship application is **Sunday, January 15, 2023**. The application must be submitted online. All supporting documentation must be received (not postmarked) by mail, emailed to FundDevelopment@gseok.org, or hand delivered to the GSEOK Hardesty Leadership Center by the deadline in order to be considered. If your official high school transcript is in a sealed envelope, leave it sealed. One reference letter is required; either from a Girl Scout adult volunteer or from a community advisor with whom you have worked.
