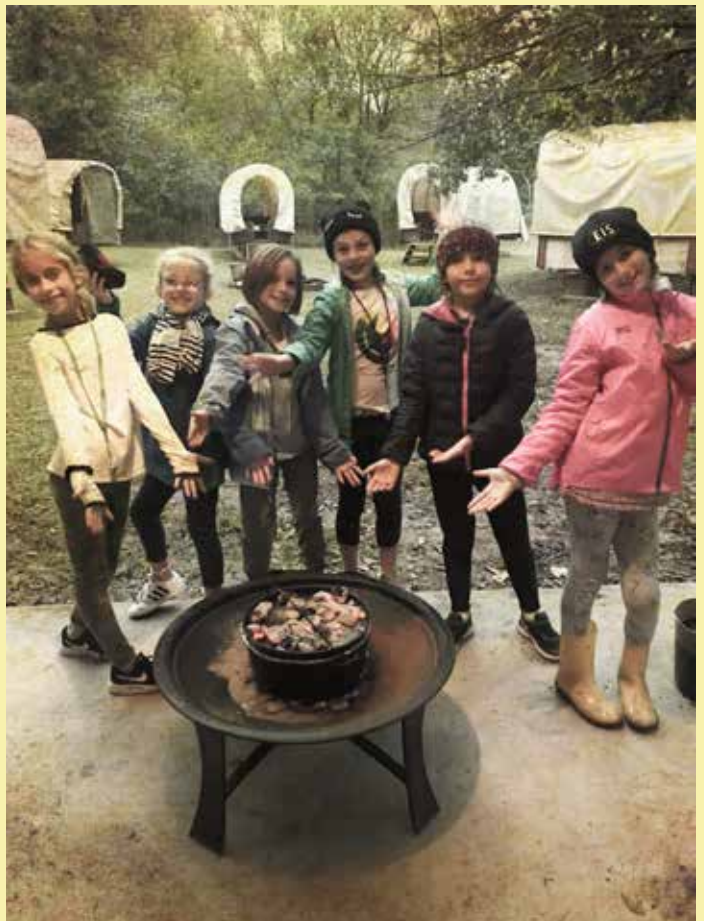
EVERY GIRL IN A TENT

G.I.R.L. 2020

October 23-25, 2020

The world's largest girl-led event for girls and young women and everyone who supports them! GSEOK plans to take a group of high-school aged girls. Applications will be provided in the spring.



INVESTITURE AND REDEDICATION CEREMONY: Fall is a great time to have a ceremony! An **Investiture** is the welcoming of new members, both girls and adults, into the Girl Scout family for the first time. Girls receive their Girl Scout, Girl Scout Brownie, or Girl Scout Daisy pin at this time. **Rededication** is the opportunity for girls and adults who are already members to renew their commitment to the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Juliette Low Leadership Society Scholarship is offered annually to registered Girl Scouts who are graduating from high school. This scholarship helps to support higher education.

Applications open November 1 and may be completed online at gseok.org/scholarship. The deadline is January 10, 2020 and applications must be postmarked by January 10.

Scholarships are presented to recipients at the annual Juliette Low Leadership Society Luncheon, which will be held Thursday, April 16, 2020.

And to live by the Girl Scout Law.

REFUND POLICY



All activities require advance registration and payment by the registration deadline.

- All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- In the event activity fees do not require a deposit, all payments made upon registration are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Cancellations must be received before the registration deadline.
- There are no refunds after the registration deadline.

The individual making the registration will be responsible for any balance due for:

- cancellations received after the registration deadline
- any balance due for girls who are “no shows”

On occasion, a third-party event will not allow us to offer a refund at any time after a registration has been made. This will be noted in the event description. Refunds for registrations made directly with a third-party must be requested from the third-party.

In the event that GSEOK has to cancel a program, a full refund will be provided. This policy includes all methods of payment, including Cookie Credit.

COOKIE CREDIT

Cookie credit works similar to your typical gift card, it is an individual reward, acknowledging a girl's hard work and entrepreneurial success. Girls can use their Cookie Credit for Girl Scout activities and merchandise.
