Dear Graduating Girl Scout,

Girl Scouts of Eastern Oklahoma is pleased to inform you that as a registered, graduating Girl Scout, you are eligible to apply for a **Juliette Low Leadership Society Scholarship** to assist you with the cost of college or technical/trade school. The funds for these scholarships are made available by generous community donors, including The John Steele Zink Foundation and Mott MacLeod Family. These donors are eager to recognize you for your commitment to Girl Scouts and to encourage you to pursue further achievement through education.

This scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, room, board and other similar costs of attending a college, university, or other accredited post-secondary education institution.

Beginning **November 29, 2021**, the scholarship application will be available online at <a href="www.gseok.org/scholarship">www.gseok.org/scholarship</a> for you to fill out and submit to the Girl Scouts of Eastern Oklahoma Scholarship Committee. Your application will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Girl Scout Experience
- Academics
- Leadership

- Service
- Essay Quality
- Financial Need

The deadline for submission of your completed scholarship application is **Friday**, **January 14**, **2022**. The application must be submitted online. All supporting documentation must be *received* (not postmarked) by mail, emailed to <a href="mailto:FundDevelopment@gseok.org">FundDevelopment@gseok.org</a>, or hand delivered to the GSEOK Hardesty Leadership Center (4810 S 129<sup>th</sup> E Ave, Tulsa, OK 74134) by the deadline in order to be considered. If your official high school transcript is in a sealed envelope, leave it sealed. Two reference letters are required; one from a Girl Scout adult volunteer and one from a community advisor with whom you have worked.

Only finalists will be called for an interview. The number of finalists will be dependent on the number of qualified applicants. You will be notified by phone or email if you have been selected as a finalist. If selected, a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee will be held in person at the GSEOK Hardesty Leadership Center or via Zoom.

Congratulations on your success in Girl Scouts and your upcoming graduation from high school! Girl Scouts of Eastern Oklahoma wishes you every success in your future endeavors.
