

DOES THIS ACTIVITY REQUIRE COUNCIL APPROVAL?

Are you planning any of these activities?

OVERNIGHT (Regardless of location or activities)

AND/OR

- Aquatic Inflatables
- Archery, 3D Archery, Slingshots
- Backpacking
- Boating: Canoes, Kayaks, Row Boats, Corcls, Sailboats
- Bounce Houses
- Camping
- Challenge Course, Climbing & Rappelling/Ziplining, Recreational Tree Climbing
- Fencing
- Fishing and Ice Fishing
- Go-Karts
- Hayrides
- Horseback Riding
- Indoor Skydiving
- Knife/Tomahawk/Hatchet Throwing
- Offshore Water/Large Passenger Vessel
- Parades and Other Large Group Gatherings (ONLY if participating, not spectating)
- Scuba Diving
- Segway
- Shooting Sports
- Skateboarding
- Snorkeling
- Snow Skiing/Snowboarding/Snowshoeing
- Spelunking/Caving
- Standup Paddle Boarding
- Surfing
- Swimming
- Target Paintball
- Tethered Balloon Rides
- Travel/Trips
- Tubing/Waterskiing/Wakeboarding
- Whitewater Rafting

*Check <u>Safety Activity Checkpoints</u> to see if you must submit a copy of certification of trained personnel for your specific activity. If provided by the facility, (example: Lifeguards at water parks) certificates do not need to be submitted.

YES, approval is required.

AND

Wilderness First Aid or Wilderness First Responder is required if EMS response is more than 30 minutes.

SUBMIT FORM #585F.

AND

All adults staying on an overnight must be registered members with a current background check.

No, activity may include:

- Going Shopping
- Touring TV/Radio or Fire Station
- Going to the Zoo
- Bowling
- Skating
- Going to Library
- Going to Amusement Park (not participating in water activities or Gocarts)
- Similar low-risk activities

Approval is not required for these types of day activities.

Most activities sponsored by the council do not require you to have specific training in addition to *GSEOK Troop Leadership* and *Beyond the Meeting* to attend and do not need council approval (submitting Form #585F). Examples: **Daisy Day is held at a council facility but does not require site orientation, outdoor training, or additional approval.

As with all troop activities, a first aider is still required.

***<u>Using council facilities for a day use or an</u> overnight requires training before use. X

- 1. Someone with your troop must have site orientation for the site.
- 2. All GSSCs, Eaton Lodge, Stillwater Lodge and the Troop House require the <u>site orientation</u> and <u>Beyond the Meeting</u> training (for simple overnights with no fire building or outdoor skills).
- 3. Camps Tallchief, Swannie and Wah-Shah-She <u>require</u> <u>site</u> <u>orientation</u>, <u>Beyond the Meeting</u> and <u>Troop Camper</u> training.
