Cookie Storage and Transportation

Cookies should be transported in vehicles and stored in areas are that clean, smoke free, dry, pest free and safe from pets.

What to Bring

- A vehicle that can hold all of your cookies. (You don't need extra adults, just one person who can count, sign and verify in eBudde.
- Your eBudde Delivery Confirmation page to verify your order.
- A pen for the counter to sign and initial forms.

Arrival & Check-in

- Please plan to <u>arrive only a few minutes before</u> your assigned pickup time.
- Text your Pickup Code (found on your eBudde Delivery Confirmation page) to check in for your troop.
- You will be greeted by staff or volunteers and given your troop's N/S4 "bubble report" and directed to your troop order.

Pickup

- You will verify that your entire order is correct before any loading begins.
- After each variety is correct, initial the corresponding spot on the bubble report.
- Your completed bubble sheet will be turned in and you will sign a receipt or check out by text. It is important to keep all receipts for your records.
- You can then load all the cookies for your troop into your vehicle.

Next Steps

• Your troop is able to pick up cookies before many in the area. It is VERY important that none of these cookies are given to girls or customers before Saturday, January 25.

Q: I am not available to pick-up cookies that day, what do I do?
