



Green ² Troops – Ambassador Girl Scout Ways Badge

Step 1: Celebrate Traditions, Sustainably

- Green² Twist:
 - Host a **zero-waste troop ceremony** (investiture, bridging, or rededication).
 - Use reusable items (scarves, recycled jars for candles, digital scripts).
 - o Challenge: design a tradition that uses *no new purchased items*.
- Girl-led Option: Ambassadors choose a tradition they want to revive or reinvent for their troop.

Step 2: Girl Scout Songs with a Modern Beat

- Green² Twist:
 - Create a playlist of Girl Scout songs recorded on phones (no paper song sheets).
 - o Remix or rewrite a classic song with lyrics about sustainability or their generation's leadership.
 - o Optional: publish digitally for younger girls no printing needed.
- Girl-led Option: Decide which songs they want to preserve and which ones to re-imagine.

Step 3: Share Girl Scout History, Digitally

- Green² Twist:
 - Instead of posters, design a digital timeline or slideshow about local GS history.
 - Record a short video interview with a lifetime member, alum, or Juliette Gordon Low re-enactor.
 - Share online with younger girls or at a service unit event no waste materials required.
- **Girl-led Option:** Ambassadors choose whether to focus on *local council history*, *national milestones*, or *their troop's own legacy*.

Step 4: Traditions with a Purpose

- Green² Twist:
 - Instead of swapping trinkets/SWAPS, host a skill swap each girl teaches another a skill (knot tying, camp cooking, yoga).
 - Create a tradition journal (digital) where each Ambassador documents a memory or skill and shares it with younger troops.
 - Optional: design a waste-free troop ritual (like gratitude circles, "Green Pledges," or eco-friendly campfires).
- Girl-led Option: Ambassadors decide what traditions matter most to pass on and how to modernize them.

Step 5: Lead the Next Generation

- Green² Twist:
 - Plan a multi-level event where Ambassadors teach Daisies, Brownies, or Juniors traditions all using only reusable, recyclable, or digital tools.
 - Could be: leading songs, teaching a sustainable SWAP, or hosting a waste-free ceremony.
 - Challenge: make the event itself zero-waste.
- Girl-led Option: Ambassadors design and run the event entirely, from planning to delivery.

Completion - To earn the Ambassador Girl Scout Ways badge in Green² format, girls must:

- Complete all five steps with waste-free practices.
- Reflect in their troop journal: "How can we honor Girl Scout traditions while making them sustainable for the future?"
- Submit a photo or short video of one tradition they modernized in a waste-free way (instead of a physical artifact).
