



# Green<sup>2</sup> Troops: Cadette Public Speaker Badge

Purpose: Build confidence in speaking to an audience while keeping your activities low-waste, techsavvy, and environmentally friendly.

## Overall Green<sup>2</sup> Strategies

- Materials: Go fully digital for scripts, cue cards, and notes.
- Props: Use items the troop already owns or can borrow.
- Venues: Choose spaces with existing sound equipment and seating to avoid rentals.
- Promotion: Share invitations and recordings online rather than printing.

## Step 1 - Get to Know Your Audience

Goal: Understand how to connect with the people you're speaking to.

- Conduct a quick online survey or poll instead of handing out paper questionnaires.
- Practice speeches for small groups at troop meetings, schools, or libraries.
- Keep audience research notes in a shared digital document.

### Step 2 - Choose a Topic You Care About

**Goal**: Select a topic that excites and inspires you.

- Focus on eco-friendly themes (waste reduction, pollinator gardens, green energy).
- Research using online sources or library books instead of buying new materials.
- Discuss topic ideas in a troop "round table" without printing handouts.

#### Step 3 - Write an Engaging Speech

Goal: Create a speech that's well-organized and memorable.

- Draft speeches on a computer or tablet—no paper needed.
- Rehearse with a buddy for feedback rather than printing multiple versions.
- Incorporate digital visuals instead of physical props when possible.

## Step 4 - Polish With Practice

Goal: Rehearse until your speech feels natural.

- Use troop meeting time for practice rather than traveling to multiple locations.
- Record practice sessions on a phone or tablet to review performance.
- Reuse any stage or podium equipment from previous troop events.

#### Step 5 - Put It Into Action

**Goal**: Deliver your speech to an audience.

- Present at a troop, service unit, school, or community meeting.
- Invite your audience digitally and livestream if possible.
- Share the recording online to reach more people instead of hosting multiple events.

## **At-Home & Family Connection**

- Practice your speech for family members and ask for feedback.
- Share your final performance video with relatives who live far away.
- Encourage your family to reduce waste by adopting a tip from your speech.

## Waste-Free Wrap-Up

- Reflect as a troop: What strategies helped you speak confidently?
- Compile a digital collection of troop speeches for future reference.
- Pass along tips to younger Girl Scouts earning similar badges.
