



#### **Green 2 Troops - Eco Learner Badge**

**Goal:** Learn how to care for nature and protect the Earth *by creating zero waste and making small changes that matter!* 

**Girl Scout Mission Connection:** Girl Scouts are leaders who take care of the Earth. This badge helps Daisies understand how they can make a difference *right now*, with simple actions that protect nature and reduce trash.

# What You'll Need (Minimal & Reused Materials)

- 1. Recycled paper or cardboard (for signs or notes)
- 2. A reusable bag
- 3. A container with a lid (to collect compostable scraps or recyclables)
- 4. Markers or crayons you already have
- 5. Nature guide, app, or printed pages (reuse from library handouts or park brochures)
- 6. Curiosity and kindness 💙

#### **Step-by-Step Activities**

#### Step 1: Watch and Wonder

**Badge Step:** Find out what makes you say "wow!" about nature

Go outside to your yard, school, or local park. Use your eyes, ears, and nose. What do you notice? A bird call? A flower shape? The wind in the trees?

### **Girl-Led Prompt:**

What's something small in nature that you think is amazing?

# Step 2: Learn About Nature's Helpers

Badge Step: Learn how animals, plants, and bugs help Earth

Choose one creature—like bees, worms, or trees—and learn how it helps the planet. Use a library book, family knowledge, or a reused printout. Then draw or write a thank-you message on scrap paper.

### **Green<sup>2</sup> Twist:**

Tape your thank-you card to your fridge, compost bin, or garden area to remind others to be eco-friendly too.

#### Step 3: Make a Green Choice

**Badge Step:** Do something helpful for nature

Pick one and do it with your adult:

Sort recycling at home
Pick up trash on your walk
Bring reusable bags to the store
Turn off lights when you leave the room

Use a cloth napkin instead of paper

# **Reflection Prompt:**

What green thing did you do today that made the Earth smile?

### **Step 4: Teach Someone**

Badge Step: Share what you learned

Create a "How I Help the Earth" poster using reused paper or cereal box cardboard. Share it with your family or troop—or take a photo to share on your council's site!

#### **Badge Complete When:**

You explored nature and found a personal "wow" moment

You learned how an animal or plant helps the Earth

You made one Earth-friendly change at home

You shared what you learned—like a real Girl Scout leader!

### **Optional Bonus Challenge:**

Start a family **Green Jar**: every time someone makes a green choice (recycles, turns off lights, uses reusable gear), add a bead or token. Set a reward for reaching 25!
