Purpose: Design and build games that bring people together and promote creativity—with an ecofriendly, minimal-waste focus.

Step 1: Break the Ice

- Create a no-waste "Minute to Win It" style game using only items found at home (old socks, scrap paper, rubber bands).
- Host a "Nature Scavenger Hunt" using naturally found items instead of printed clues.

Step 2: Imagine All the World's a Game Board

- Design a giant, reusable floor game using scrap fabric, cardboard, and natural markers like rocks or sticks.
- Sketch and plan a life-size outdoor game (capture the flag, obstacle course) that uses no new materials.

Step 3: Create Your Game

- Build board games or card games exclusively from recycled materials (old cereal boxes, scrap wood, cloth scraps).
- Invent a storytelling-based game using reusable "story tokens" made from upcycled materials.

Step 4: Test Your Game

- Host a zero-waste "Game Night" where teams playtest each other's creations.
- Take games to a local farmers market, library, or community event for live playtesting with reusable scorecards.

Step 5: Share Your Game

- Organize a "Sustainable Game Showcase" at a local park or green space using reusable booths/signs.
- Donate finished games to schools, community centers, or libraries, ensuring all pieces are made from eco-friendly or recycled materials.

Optional Community Service Project:

- Host a "Waste-Free Family Game Day" at a community center to promote sustainability, family bonding, and creativity.
- Create a "Recycled Game Kit" initiative: collect recycled supplies and build game kits for after-school programs or shelters.
