Step 1: Research Destinations

- Choose eco-friendly travel locations that prioritize sustainability, such as national parks, green cities, or conservation-focused destinations.
- Use digital tools only (no printed brochures) to research travel options and eco-tourism opportunities.

Step 2: Make a Travel Budget

- Create a digital travel budget spreadsheet that includes sustainable choices (e.g., public transit, reusable supplies).
- Prioritize locally-owned accommodations and eco-certified businesses to support green tourism.

Step 3: Find Out How to Travel Light

- Host a "Zero-Waste Packing Challenge" where girls brainstorm how to pack light using only reusable or multi-purpose items.
- Create a digital "green packing list" that includes items like reusable water bottles, bamboo utensils, & cloth bags.

Step 4: Plan Your Trip

- Design a zero-waste travel itinerary, including low-emission transportation and waste-free dining options.
- Plan meals and snacks that avoid single-use packaging, using reusable containers.

Step 5: Go on Your Trip

- Implement your zero-waste plan during a day trip or overnight adventure, tracking how much waste was avoided.
- Document the trip using digital journals or blogs instead of paper scrapbooks.

Community Service Project:

- Organize a "Travel Green Fair" to teach other troops or community members about waste-free and eco-friendly travel practices.
- Partner with a local tourism board to promote sustainable tourism practices in your community.
