Purpose: Step into the spotlight and share your performance skills—whether it’s acting, singing, dancing, or another form of stage art—while keeping the process low-waste and eco-friendly.

Overall Green² Strategies

- Materials: Use what you already have, borrow, thrift, or make from recycled items.
 - Scripts & Music: Go digital or use repurposed paper.
 - Costumes & Props: Rely on wardrobe swaps, upcycled fabrics, and secondhand finds.
 - Sets & Staging: Think minimalist—let the performance be the focus rather than elaborate, disposable sets.
 - Promotion: Share digitally rather than printing flyers.
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Step 1: Pick Your Performance Style

Goal: Choose the type of performance you want to create and present.

- Research performance ideas using online public domain scripts, music, or monologues.
 - Host a brainstorming circle where each girl pitches a performance style (spoken word, music, improvisation).
 - Girl-led Tip: Vote as a troop to decide what fits your talents and interests best.
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Step 2: Build Your Skills

Goal: Practice the techniques needed for your chosen performance.

- Use free online tutorials or library books instead of printed guides.
 - Host a “skills swap” session where each girl teaches a technique (e.g., projecting your voice, stage movement).
 - Practice in a local park, backyard, or community room to avoid renting extra space.
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Step 3: Rehearse Without the Waste

Goal: Polish your performance while minimizing impact on the environment.

- Rehearse with reusable props (household items, fabric scraps, old costume jewelry).
 - Store all costumes and props in reusable totes or bins for future performances.
 - Use phones or tablets to record rehearsals for self-review rather than printing notes.
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Step 4: Prepare the Stage

Goal: Set up your performance environment in an eco-friendly way.

- Choose a venue that already has lighting and sound equipment.
 - Use existing furniture or borrowed items instead of building disposable sets.
 - Incorporate natural backdrops or blank walls rather than painted scenery.
 - Keep décor minimal or use reusable banners and fabric backdrops.
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Step 5: Put on Your Show

Goal: Share your performance with an audience.

- Invite the audience digitally (email, text, social media, troop group chats).
- Allow “pay what you can” donations toward a troop or council sustainability cause.
- After the show, store all reusable materials for another troop to use.
- Consider recording the performance to share online rather than handing out physical programs.

At-Home & Family Connection

- Ask your family to help you source costumes from closets or thrift stores.
- Practice your performance at home with your family as the first audience.
- Share your eco-friendly performance tips with friends and family to inspire them.
