Purpose: Learn how to distinguish fact from fiction and explore different points of view using responsible, eco-conscious practices.

Step 1: Find Some Truths About the World

- Research current events using only online sources or e-books to reduce paper use.
- Listen to podcasts or attend virtual speaker sessions focused on truth in journalism and advocacy.

Step 2: Evaluate the Source

- Host a digital-only "Source Scavenger Hunt" where girls evaluate online articles for credibility.
- Create a recycled-material "Truth or Trash" sorting game, where examples of good and bad sources are placed on repurposed boards.

Step 3: Find the Roots of a Debatable Issue

- Choose an environmental or animal welfare issue and research both sides using a shared digital document.
- Host a "Green Debate" using reusable boards for argument mapping.

Step 4: Figure Out How to Share What You've Learned

- Create an eco-conscious PSA (Public Service Announcement) video instead of printing flyers.
- Launch a podcast episode or YouTube video to share findings, minimizing paper use.

Step 5: Put Your Skills Into Action

- Present findings at a troop or community meeting using only reusable or digital presentation tools.
- Host a "Truth & Sustainability" workshop at a local library using repurposed materials for visuals.

Optional Community Service Project:

- Partner with a community center or school to teach younger students about critical thinking and sustainability practices, using zero-waste teaching materials.
- Organize a "Truth for the Planet" campaign, spreading fact-based environmental awareness using only reusable displays and social media.
