Theme: Career Readiness, First Jobs, and Real Experience

Boss Name: *The Gatekeeper of Gaps*

The Gatekeeper stands at the edge of opportunity, scoffing at every résumé with “*not enough experience.*” She hoards internships, cool titles, and mentorships—unless someone breaks the cycle.

Boss Weakness: Strategic résumé-building, personal branding, and demonstrating transferable skills.

Strategy Options:

1. Build a Résumé that reflects volunteer work, leadership, and real accomplishments (*Research & Development*).
2. Create a Personal Pitch that communicates value (*Entrepreneur Accelerator*).
3. Advocate for Yourself in mock interviews or policy conversations (*Public Policy*).

Choose Your Role:

- The Storycrafter – Connects past experiences to future goals with compelling language.
- The Brand Strategist – Builds an image that’s authentic, confident, and consistent.
- The Policy Challenger – Questions hiring practices and advocates for equity in opportunity.

Quest Log: Task

Build or update your résumé. Use Girl Scout experiences to show leadership, planning, and teamwork.

Record a 1-minute pitch about who you are and what you bring to the table.

Interview someone with a cool job: How did they get started? What advice would they give their younger self?

Apply for a real opportunity (volunteer, job, grant, scholarship). Reflect on the process.

Create a mock job listing for “YOU, LLC.” What are your top 3 skills, values, and achievements?

Reflection:

- What have I done that others might overlook, but that shows my power?
- How do I want people to *feel* when they read my résumé or hear my pitch?
- What kind of work excites me—and why?

Victory Stamp:

A résumé with wings—or a name tag glowing with confidence.
