



## Leader's Quest: Daisy "Tidy Tornado"

**Theme:** Responsibility and taking care of your space

**Focus:** Girls learn to be helpful at home, in their troop, and in shared spaces — without being told!

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### Mission Briefing - Hello, Daisy Hero!

A messy monster named "The Tidy Tornado" is swirling through your troop and leaving things scattered *everywhere*. She says girls can't clean up or take care of things on their own. Let's prove her wrong!

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### Boss Profile:

Boss Name: The Tidy Tornado

Weakness: Responsibility and helpful habits

Battlefield: Meeting space, classroom, or home

Victory Condition: Girls complete a challenge where they take care of something without being asked.

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### Battle Strategy (Pick 2):

- Troop Clean Sweep: Girls choose one part of the troop space to tidy up (supplies, books, art bin).
- Pack & Prep Patrol: Girls help at the next meeting by setting out chairs, packing supplies, or helping the leader.
- Fix-It Challenge: Girls work together to "rescue" a messy area using teamwork and creativity.
- Daisy Duty Jobs: Girls rotate simple jobs like Line Leader, Snack Helper, and Light Checker — and reflect on how it feels to be responsible.

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### Girl Role Cards (Pick Yours):

- Fix-It Fox: You spot what needs cleaning or fixing and jump into action.
- Helper Hawk: You quietly help without being asked — like a secret service agent of helpfulness.
- Ready Rabbit: You love to prep supplies and set up for others.
- Care Captain: You check on shared spaces and make sure everything's respected and neat.

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### Quest Log:

- What did I help clean, organize, or care for?
- How did I feel after doing it?
- Did I do it without being asked?

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### Side Quest:

Choose one job at home and do it *every day* for a week — no reminders.

Draw or write what you did and how it felt.

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### Level-Up Reflection:

- Why is it important to take care of your space?
- Did anyone notice what you did?
- Would you do it again even if no one sees?

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### Victory Stamp:

[Draw a broom, dustpan, badge, or star! Or give yourself a sparkly sticker of honor.]
