



Leader's Quest: Senior "The Silence Circuit Boss Battle"

Theme: Voice, Advocacy & The Power of the Unsaid

Senior Badges Integrated:

Truth Seeker

Public Policy

Women's Health

Boss Name: *Mutech, Architect of the Silence Circuit*

She operates in grayscale—a world where people stay quiet, where “It’s fine” is the answer to everything, and where no one asks *why*. Mutech’s Circuit powers systems that ignore hard truths, especially when they affect girls and women. Her weakness? Bold voices and questions that *don’t stop*.

Boss Weakness: Unfiltered truth, policy curiosity, and speaking up even when it’s uncomfortable.

Strategy Options:

1. Track a Truth—Pick a topic you care about and follow the trail to find out who controls the outcome (*Truth Seeker*).
 2. Break the Policy Code—Choose an issue and map out how a change *could* happen (*Public Policy*).
 3. Start the Conversation—Talk about something “uncomfortable” (body image, mental health) with trusted peers (*Women’s Health*).
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Choose Your Role:

- The Decoder – Digs deep to expose buried truths and distorted narratives.
 - The Systems Hacker – Reads between the lines of power structures and imagines new ones.
 - The Pulse Finder – Speaks about things others avoid—and makes it safe for others to follow.
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Quest Log: Task

Choose one “unsaid truth” that impacts girls (at school, online, in society). Research it.

Interview someone affected by that truth. What have they experienced? What do they wish others understood?

Map how policy or laws affect that topic. Who has the power to make change? What would you change first?

Write a monologue, poem, or blog post to break the silence on this issue. Share it anonymously or out loud.

Create a short PSA, zine, or campaign poster about your topic. Try to include stats, emotions, and a call to action.

Reflection:

- What is something I’ve stayed silent about that needs to be heard?
 - Who benefits when people don’t ask questions?
 - How can I use my voice to make room for others?
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Victory Stamp:

A shattered speaker, finally emitting sound—or a page full of redacted text, now unmarked and free.
