The Girl Scout Leadership Experience

Through the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, girls are encouraged to Discover themselves, Connect with others, and Take Action to make the world a better place. Girl Scouts achieve these skills by participating in – Girl-led activities, Learning-by-Doing, and Cooperative Learning opportunities. With the help of supportive adults and troop leaders who bring these processes to life, girls can try new things, share their full selves, and see how good it feels to lead from the heart. These guiding principles support the Girl Scout mission and everything we do.

- Leaders have completed annual 'Child Abuse and Neglect' training.
